NEWS FLASH: OSHA has proposed a 500% increase in fines! More changes to work place PPE requirements. Learn some of the changes to workplace safety.

EPA issued a \$12 million fine in December 2021 to a large pesticide applicator for failing to follow label instructions. Do you know the rules that could affect you?

Last year alone there were more than 30,000 spills large enough to require reporting to the federal government. Failure to make the necessary notifications can result in substantial fines. Fuel products require reporting in some situations if only one drop is spilled. Do you know what they are?
