**NEWS FLASH:** OSHA's Heat Stress Standard is being enforced! Do you know the requirements for 2023. More changes to work place PPE requirements. Learn some of the changes to workplace safety.

EPA has raised the penalty for a pesticide violation to \$21,805 per day! Are your applicators following all the label instructions? Learn the rule changes that will directly affect you and your business!

Last year alone there were more than 30,000 spills large enough to require reporting to the federal government. Failure to make the necessary notifications can result in substantial fines. Fuel products require reporting in some situations if only one drop is spilled. Do you know what they are?

**Do you have fuel tanks? If so, you could be subject to EPA's Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasures rule (SPCC). Are you prepared?**

An employee placed a zip tie on a fuel dispenser, resulting in a \$500,000 clean up, \$90,000 fine and criminal charges against the employee. The company was required to pay all clean up costs.

**OSHA requires spill response training for employees responding to an emergency.** Responding to a spill utilizing your own personnel and equipment costs a fraction of what an environmental contractor would charge you. Even after a traffic accident *regardless of fault* any spilled fuel products or pesticides must be cleaned up!
