EPA is targeting individuals for improper use of pesticides, with fines up to \$24,885 per day! Are your applicators following all the label instructions? Keep up with the changes that could affect you and your business!

Last year alone there were more than 30,000 spills large enough to require reporting to the federal government. Failure to make the necessary notifications can result in substantial fines. Fuel products require reporting in some situations if only one drop is spilled. Do you know what they are?
